

Time for the Summer Beer Festival

Our local micro-breweries, including the Detroit Beer Company, Big Rock, Rochester Mills, Royal Oak Brewery, Grizzly Peak, Bastone and Blue Tractor, and dozens of other Michigan craft breweries, will offer a sampling of their wares at the Summer Beer Festival in Ypsilanti's Riverside Park this Friday from 5-9 p.m. and Saturday from 1-6 p.m.

The 21 and over event, the 12th annual, will include lots of appropriate fare, including pulled pork sandwiches, ribs and corn on the cob, to accompany the brews. Tickets are \$30 on Friday, \$35 on Saturday and their are \$5 designated driver tickets as well.

This year the festival, sponsored by the Michigan Brewers Guild, is going green, with recycling bins throughout the festival grounds, biodegradable plates, bowls, cups and hand towels, and food scraps hauled to a local pig farmer.
