 - **Jagermeister Schnitzel** – Thin sliced pork loin breaded and pan-fried with smoked mushrooms, sage spaetzle and Jagermeister pan gravy for \$12.95.
 - **Vegetarian Stuffed Cabbage** – Tender cabbage leaves with cheddar cheese potato stuffing, homemade spaetzle and roasted fennel cream for \$10.95.
 - **Grilled Bratwurst** – Locally made bratwurst with a sharp cheddar ale fondue, and a warm potato and green bean salad for \$11.95.
