



It's Cinco de Mayo all month at Café Habana

If you missed celebrating Cinco de Mayo this week, fear not. Cafe Habana in Royal Oak is extending the event all through the month of May. The restaurant, at 109 Fifth St., is offering a special Mexican menu, including house-made tamales, arepas (cornmeal pancakes with spicy pork, chilies, avocado and olives), sauteed walleye with cilantro/tomatillo rice and yucca chips, and baked chicken picante nachos, all in a price range of \$8-\$15. They'll toss in a craft beer for \$2.50.

Cafe Habana is open from 11 a.m.-11 p.m. Mon.-Fri., 9 a.m.-midnight Sat., and 9 a.m.-10 p.m. Sun., but note that the Mexican menu is served only after 4 p.m. [Call](#) (248) 544-6255.
