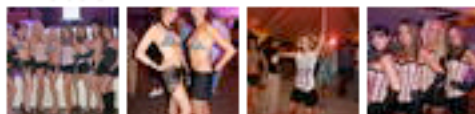
## Crush

This Thursday, in celebration of **Vinoteca**'s fourth anniversary, you'll not only get to crush your own grapes but taste up to 30 wines and sample food and Bastone's own craft-brewed beers.

"This celebration is not only to honor our birthday but also to honor our customers because they are the reason we are still here and going strong," says Assistant Manager Bronwen Nikora.
